1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notice 2021 (No 123).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences at 4:00pm (AEST) on 25 June 2021.

3 COVID-19 affected areas, COVID-19 places of high concern, and COVID-19 places of concern

I, Dr Kerryn Coleman, Chief Health Officer, identify each area or place mentioned in:

- a. Schedule 1, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 affected area; and
- b. Schedule 2, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be an affected area subject to a stay-at-home requirement, and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule; and
- c. Schedule 3, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 Place of Concern and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule.

4 Definitions of terms within this Notice

Definitions of words or terms specific to this Notice are set out in Schedule 4.

5 Revocation

This instrument revokes all previous Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notices.

Stay at Home – Metropolitan Sydney Local Government Areas

The following conditions apply to all Places outlined in the table below.

For all travellers who leave a Metropolitan Sydney Local Government Areas (LGAs) listed in the table below between 4:00pm on Friday 25 June 2021 until at least 11:59pm on Friday 2 July 2021:

- 1. Individuals are required to stay at home unless:
 - o To undertake essential work or study, if they cannot work or study from home or remotely.
 - To attend usual childcare arrangements, where parents or guardians need to undertake essential work or study
 - To shop for essentials like groceries, medicine, and necessary supplies
 - To attend to medical or health care needs including compassionate requirements, and looking after the vulnerable
 - To attend a facility to receive a COVID-19 vaccination, where the individual is eligible for a vaccination in the ACT, an appointment has been booked, and the individual is not in isolation or in quarantine
 - o To exercise outdoors, limited to one hour per day
 - For essential animal welfare purposes (e.g. to feed pets or livestock that live elsewhere)
 - Leaving due to an emergency
- 2. All individuals aged 12 years and over must wear a mask at all times upon leaving their premises for the abovementioned reasons. Mask wearing is not required if individuals are undertaking vigorous exercise outdoors.

In addition, the following conditions outlined in the *Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction* 2021, must be complied with:

Residents of the ACT must:

- 1. Complete a self-declaration form within 24 hours prior to arriving in the ACT, or within 24 hours from the commencement of a COVID-19 area of concern notice.
- Monitor for symptoms for 14 days from the date last in the area, and if you experience any symptoms of COVID-19 go to a COVID-19 clinic to be tested.

Non-Residents of the ACT must:

- 1. Not enter the ACT unless they obtain an exemption before arriving.
- 2. Where an exemption has been granted, comply with all Stay at Home requirements and/or any conditions outlined in the exemption documentation.

- If you have been to a COVID-19 Place of Concern (Close Contact Exposure site or Casual Contact Exposure site) you
 must comply with the requirements outlined in Schedule 3.

COVID-19 Places of Concern

Note:

Persons who are not affected persons but have been in a COVID-19 Place of Concern must comply

Area of Concern - State of Victoria

The following conditions apply to the State of Victoria.

For all travellers who have spent any time in the State of Victoria in the last 14 days and are seeking to enter the ACT between 11:59pm on Thursday 24 June 2021 and 11:59pm on Thursday 1 July 2021:

1. You must first comply with all public health directions in place within the jurisdiction you are currently in, and

If you are permitted to travel you must:

- 2. Complete a self-declaration form within 24 hours prior to arriving in the ACT, or within 24 hours from the commencement of a COVID-19 area of concern notice.
- 3. Monitor for symptoms for 14 days from the date last in the area, and if you experience any symptoms of COVID-19 go to a COVID-19 clinic to be tested.

- c. enters the ACT by road for transport or freight purposes (including furniture removalists); or
- d. arrives in the ACT by air for the purpose of transiting to another destination, and does not leave the Canberra Airport; or
- e. arrives in the ACT by road or air for the purpose of transiting to NSW by road and immediately does so; or
- f. had undergone an unbroken 14-day period of hotel quarantine in Australia following a flight that originated from overseas, and has travelled directly to the ACT immediately upon completion of quarantine.

- Continue to monitor for symptoms for 14 days from the date last in a listed exposure location, and if you experience any symptoms of COVID-19 go to a COVID clinic to be retested.
