1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notice* 2021 (No 19).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences at 10.00am (AEST) on 25 April 2021.

3 COVID-19 affected areas, COVID-19 places of high concern, and COVID-19 places of concern

I, Dr Kerryn Coleman, Chief Health Officer, identify each area or place mentioned in:

- a. Schedule 1, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 affected area; and
- b. Schedule 2, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be an area subject to a Stay at Home Requirement, and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule; and
- c. Schedule 3, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 Place of Concern and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule
