Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notice 2021 (No 37)

made under the

Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction 2021, paragraph 1

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notice 2021 (No 37)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences at 12.00pm (AEST) on 14 May 2021.

3 COVID-19 affected areas, COVID-19 places of high concern, and COVID-19 places of concern

I, Dr Kerryn Coleman, Chief Health Officer, identify each area or place mentioned in:

- a. Schedule 1, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 affected area; and
- b. Schedule 2, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be an affected area subject to a stay-at-home requirement, and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule; and
- c. Schedule 3, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 Place of Concern and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule

4 Definitions of terms within this Notice

Definitions of words or terms specific to this Notice are set out in Schedule 4.

5 Revocation

This instrument revokes all previous Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Notices.

1. On arrival to the ACT immediately attend a COVID-19 testing centre to undergo a COVID-19 test.
2. Isolate at your place of residence or other suitable accommodation until informed of a negative test result.
3. Continue to monitor for symptoms for 14 days from the date last in a listed exposure location, and if you experience any symptoms of COVID-19 go to a COVID clinic to be retested.

Note: Points 1 and 2 do not apply if a negative test result was obtained in Victoria, or another jurisdiction, after attending the exposure site and prior to entering the ACT.

- 1 **Authorised person** means an authorised person under section 121 of the *Public Health Act 1997*.
- 2 **Private Vehicle** means a vehicle other than a vehicle operated for public transport or ride-share services.
