made under the

Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction 2021, paragraph 1

## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notice 2021 (No 455)*.

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences at 3:30pm (AEDT) on 1 January 2022.


## 3 COVID-19 affected areas, COVID-19 places of concern, close contact exposure locations and casual contact exposure locations

I, Dr Kerry Coleman, Chief Health Officer, identify each area or place mentioned in:

- a. Schedule 1, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 affected area; and
- b. Schedule 2, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 Place of Concern; and
- c. Schedule 3, at or during the stated time for the area or place, to be a Close Contact Exposure Location and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule; and
- d. Schedule 4, at or during the stated time for the area or place, to be a Casual Contact Exposure Location and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule.

## 4 Revocation

This instrument revokes all previous Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notices.

4. Not attend a high-risk setting from day 8 to 14 since last attending the exposure location, unless the setting is their usual residence or exempted by an authorised public health officer.
5. Monitor for symptoms for 14 days from the date last in a listed exposure location, and if they experience any symptoms of COVID-19, they must go to a COVID-19 testing clinic to be retested.
6. For the purposes of point 3 above, a COVID-19 test means:
  - a. For a person who has symptoms consistent with COVID-19, a PCR test.
  - b. For a person who does not have symptoms consistent with COVID-19, a Rapid Antigen Test.
    - i. Where a Rapid Antigen Test cannot be accessed, a PCR test must be undertaken.
7. For persons who undertake a Rapid Antigen Test and return a positive detection for COVID-19, they must also undertake a PCR test.
