Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notice 2021 (No 90)

made under the

Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction 2021, paragraph 1

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notice 2021 (No 90)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences at 4:30pm (AEST) on 10 June 2021.

3 COVID-19 affected areas, COVID-19 places of high concern, and COVID-19 places of concern

I, Dr Kerry Coleman, Chief Health Officer, identify each area or place mentioned in:


- a. Schedule 1, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 affected area; and
- b. Schedule 2, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be an affected area subject to a stay-at-home requirement, and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule; and
- c. Schedule 3, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 Place of Concern and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule.

4 Definitions of terms within this Notice

Definitions of words or terms specific to this Notice are set out in Schedule 4.

5 Revocation

This instrument revokes all previous Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notices.

SCHEDULE 2

Affected Areas subject to a Stay at Home Requirement

The following conditions apply to the State of Victoria

For all travellers who leave Victoria and enter the ACT between 11:59pm on Thursday 27 May 2021 and 11:59pm on Thursday 10 June 2021:

1. Individuals are required to stay at home unless:
 - To undertake essential work or study if you cannot work or study from home or remotely.
 - To attend usual childcare arrangements, where parents or guardians need to undertake essential work or study.
 - To shop for essentials like groceries, medicine and necessary supplies.
 - To attend to medical or health care needs including compassionate requirements, looking after the vulnerable.
 - To attend a facility to receive a COVID-19 vaccination, where the individual is eligible for a vaccination in the ACT, an appointment has been booked, and the individual is not in isolation or in quarantine.
 - To exercise outdoors, limited to one hour per day.
 - For essential animal welfare purposes (e.g. to feed pets or livestock that live elsewhere).
2. All individuals aged 12 years and over must wear a mask at all times upon leaving their premises for the above-mentioned reasons. Mask wearing is not required if individuals are undertaking vigorous exercise outdoors.

In addition, the following conditions outlined in the *Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction 2021*, must be complied with:

Residents of the ACT must:

1. Complete a self-declaration form within 24 hours prior to arriving in the ACT, or within 24 hours from the commencement of a COVID-19 area of concern notice.
2. Monitor for symptoms for 14 days from the date last in the area, and if you experience any symptoms of COVID-19 go to a COVID-19 clinic to be tested.

Non-Residents of the ACT must:

1. Not enter the ACT unless they obtain an exemption before arriving.
2. Where an exemption has been granted, comply with all Stay at Home requirements and/or any conditions outlined in the exemption documentation.

Note: The Stay at Home requirements do not apply if travellers left Victoria prior to 11:59pm on Thursday 27 May 2021, and have not been to a COVID-19 Place of Concern as outlined in Schedule 3 of this Notice.

Note: All Travellers who have been to a Close Contact Exposure location, as outlined in Schedule 3, must comply with the conditions outlined in Schedule 3.

2. Monitor for symptoms for 14 days from the date last in the area, and if you experience any symptoms of COVID-19 go to a COVID-19 clinic to be tested.

Note: This requirement only applies to travellers who have entered the ACT or who are no longer in the Greater Melbourne area but have spent time in the area in the last 14 days. Travellers who are entering the ACT directly from Victoria after 11:59pm on Thursday 27 May must comply with the Stay at Home requirements outlined in Schedule 2.

Note: Point 1 does not apply if the traveller:

- a. only transited Greater Melbourne by road or rail, including to attend an airport (other than a close contact exposure site located within the airport) provided the person did not exit the airport or the motor vehicle or train in which the person was travelling; or
- b. enters the ACT for urgent medical, law enforcement or emergency purposes; or
- c. enters the ACT by road for transport or freight purposes (including furniture removalists); or
- d. arrives in the ACT by air for the purpose of transiting to another destination, and does not leave the Canberra Airport; or
- e. arrives in the ACT by road or air for the purpose of transiting to NSW by road and immediately does so; or
- f. had undergone an unbroken 14-day period of hotel quarantine in Australia following a flight that originated from overseas, and has travelled directly to the ACT immediately upon completion of quarantine.
