Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notice 2021 (No 16)

made under the

Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction 2021, paragraph 1

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notice 2021 (No 16)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences at 12:00pm (AEDT) on 13 April 2021.

3 COVID-19 affected areas, COVID-19 places of high concern, and COVID-19 places of concern

I, Dr Kerryn Coleman, Chief Health Officer, identify each area or place mentioned in:

- a. Schedule 1, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 affected area; and
- b. Schedule 2, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 Place of High Concern; and
- c. Schedule 3, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 Place of Concern and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule.

4 Definitions of terms within this Notice

Definitions of words or terms specific to this Notice are set out in Schedule 4.

SCHEDULE 1

COVID-19 affected areas

Note:

Affected persons who are ACT residents must comply with Part 2 of the Direction.

Affected persons who are not ACT residents but who are already within the ACT prior to commencement of this Notice must comply with Part 4 of the Direction. All other non-ACT residents who are affected persons must comply with Part 3 of the Direction.

SCHEDULE 2

COVID-19 Places of High Concern

Note:

Persons who are not affected persons but have been in a COVID-19 Place of High Concern must comply with Part 5 of the Direction.

Persons who are not affected persons but have been in a COVID-19 Place of Concern must comply with Part 6 of the Direction.

Definitions

- 1 **Authorised person** means an authorised person under section 121 of the *Public Health Act 1997*.
- 2 **Private Vehicle** means a vehicle other than a vehicle operated for public transport or ride-share services.

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
