# Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notice 2021 (No 348)

made under the

Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction 2021, paragraph 1

## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notice 2021 (No 348)*.

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences at 5:00pm (AEDT) on 24 October 2021.

## 3 COVID-19 affected areas, COVID-19 places of high concern, and COVID-19 places of concern

I, Dr Kerryn Coleman, Chief Health Officer, identify each area or place mentioned in:

- a. Schedule 1, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 affected area; and
- b. Schedule 2, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be an affected area subject to a stay-at-home requirement, and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule; and
- c. Schedule 3, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 Place of Concern and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule.

## 4 Definitions of terms within this Notice

Definitions of words or terms specific to this Notice are set out in Schedule 4.

## 5 Revocation

This instrument revokes all previous Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notices.

## SCHEDULE 1

## COVID-19 Affected Areas

**Note:**

Affected persons who are ACT residents must comply with Part 2 of the Direction.

Affected persons who are not ACT residents but who are already within the ACT prior to commencement of this Notice must comply with Part 4 of the Direction. All other non-ACT residents who are affected persons must comply with Part 3 of the Direction.

### Quarantine – New South Wales

#### The following conditions apply to the State of New South Wales

##### For all travellers who have spent any time in the previous 14 days in New South Wales:

1. Individuals are required to *quarantine* in accordance with the **Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction 2021** for a period of 14 days after leaving the State of New South Wales or until advised by an **authorised person** within ACT Health.
2. Individuals are NOT permitted to leave their premises other than in an emergency.
3. Individuals are NOT permitted to allow any other person that does not reside at their designated premises to enter the premises, unless for medical, law enforcement or emergency purposes.

**In addition, the following conditions outlined in the *Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction 2021*, must be complied with:**

##### Residents of the ACT must:

1. Complete an exemption form within 72 hours of their intended arrival into the ACT.
2. An exemption confirming the ACT resident's ability to enter the ACT will be issued following verification of identity, residency, suitability of place of residence for quarantine, and – where required – confirmation of authority to leave the jurisdiction in which the person is currently located.

##### Non-Residents of the ACT must:

1. Not enter the ACT unless they obtain an exemption before arriving.
2. Where an exemption has been granted, comply with all requirements and/or conditions outlined in the exemption documentation.

# COVID-19 Affected Areas

**Note:**

Affected persons who are ACT residents must comply with Part 2 of the Direction.

Affected persons who are not ACT residents but who are already within the ACT prior to commencement of this Notice must comply with Part 4 of the Direction. All other non-ACT residents who are affected persons must comply with Part 3 of the Direction.

## Quarantine – State of Victoria

### The following conditions apply to the State of Victoria

**For all travellers who have spent any time in the State of Victoria in the past 14 days:**

1. Individuals are required to quarantine in accordance with the Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction 2021 for a period of 14 days after leaving the State of Victoria or until advised by an authorised person within ACT Health.
2. Individuals are NOT permitted to leave their premises other than in an emergency.
3. Individuals are NOT permitted to allow any other person that does not reside at their designated premises to enter the premises, unless for medical, law enforcement or emergency purposes.

**In addition, the following conditions outlined in the *Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction 2021*, must be complied with:**

**Residents of the ACT must:**

1. Complete an exemption form within 72 hours of their intended arrival into the ACT.
2. An exemption confirming the ACT resident's ability to enter the ACT will be issued following verification of identity, residency, suitability of place of residence for quarantine, and – where required – confirmation of authority to leave the jurisdiction in which the person is currently located.

**Non-Residents of the ACT must:**

1. Not enter the ACT unless they obtain an exemption before arriving.
2. Where an exemption has been granted, comply with all requirements and/or conditions outlined in the exemption documentation.

6. Undergo appropriate testing for COVID-19, regardless of whether symptoms are present, as advised by an **authorised person** within ACT Health.
  - c. Persons who were at a casual contact location less than 4 days ago will need to undergo two tests. The person is to undergo the first test upon learning that they are a casual contact. The person must undergo a second test on day 5 after the person was at the casual contact location. The person must remain in quarantine for the whole time, which only concludes once the person receives a negative test result from the **second test**.
  - d. Persons who were at a casual contact location 4 or more days ago will only need to undergo one test, to be conducted as soon as possible upon learning that they are a casual contact. The person must remain in quarantine until the person receives a negative test result.
7. Quarantine at your place of residence or other suitable accommodation until informed of a negative test result.
8. Continue to monitor for symptoms for 14 days from the date last in a listed exposure location, and if you experience any symptoms of COVID-19 go to a COVID clinic to be retested.

**Note:** Points 2 and 3 continue to apply regardless of whether a negative test result was obtained in another jurisdiction.

Irrespective of tests conducted under Point 2, persons who are Casual Contacts should get tested again for COVID-19 if the person experiences any symptoms of COVID-19, no matter how mild.

3. Quarantine at your place of residence or other suitable accommodation until informed of a negative test result.
4. Continue to monitor for symptoms for 14 days from the date last in a listed exposure location, and if you experience any symptoms of COVID-19 go to a COVID clinic to be retested.
