Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction 2021, paragraph 1

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notice 2021 (No 164).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences at 10:30am (AEST) on 14 July 2021.

3 COVID-19 affected areas, COVID-19 places of high concern, and COVID-19 places of concern

I, Dr Kerryn Coleman, Chief Health Officer, identify each area or place mentioned in:

- a. Schedule 1, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 affected area; and
- b. Schedule 2, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be an affected area subject to a stay-at-home requirement, and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule; and
- c. Schedule 3, at or during the stated times for the area or place, to be a COVID-19 Place of Concern and subject to any conditions or guidance listed in the Schedule.

4 Definitions of terms within this Notice

Definitions of words or terms specific to this Notice are set out in Schedule 4.

5 Revocation

This instrument revokes all previous Public Health (COVID-19 Areas of Concern) Notices.

SCHEDULE 1

COVID-19 Affected Areas

Note:

Affected persons who are ACT residents must comply with Part 2 of the Direction.

Affected persons who are not ACT residents but who are already within the ACT prior to commencement of this Notice must comply with Part 4 of the Direction. All other non-ACT residents who are affected persons must comply with Part 3 of the Direction.

Quarantine – New South Wales

The following conditions apply to all Areas outlined in the table below.

For all travellers who leave any of the New South Wales Local Government Areas (LGAs) listed in the table below on or after 11:59pm on Friday 9 July 2021 :

- Individuals are required to *quarantine* in accordance with the *Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction 2021* for a period of 14 days after leaving the affected LGA or until advised by an authorised person within ACT Health.
- 2. Individuals are NOT permitted to leave their premises other than in an emergency.
- 3. Individuals are NOT permitted to allow any other person that does not reside at their designated premises to enter the premises, unless for medical, law enforcement or emergency purposes.

In addition, the following conditions outlined in the *Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction* 2021, must be complied with:

Residents of the ACT must:

- 1. Complete an exemption form within 24 hours of their intended arrival into the ACT.
- An exemption confirming the ACT resident's ability to enter the ACT will be issued following verification of identity, residency, suitability of place of residence for quarantine, and – where required - confirmation of authority to leave the jurisdiction in which the person is currently located.

Non-Residents of the ACT must:

- 1. Not enter the ACT unless they obtain an exemption before arriving.
- Where an exemption has been granted, comply with all requirements and/or conditions outlined in the exemption documentation.

SCHEDULE 2

Affected Areas subject to a Stay at Home Requirement

Stay at Home – New South Wales

The following conditions apply to all Areas outlined in the table below.

For all travellers who have spent any time in the last 14 days in one or more of the New South Wales Local Government Areas (LGAs) listed in the table below <u>and</u> who left prior to 11:59pm on Friday 9 July 2021:

 Individuals are required to Stay at Home until <u>11:59pm (AEST) on 16 July 2021, or until advised by an authorised person</u> within ACT Health.

Individuals are permitted to leave their premises for the following:

- a. To undertake essential work or study, if they cannot work or study from home or remotely.
- b. To attend usual childcare arrangements, where parents or guardians need to undertake essential work or study.
- c. To shop for essentials like groceries, medicine, and necessary supplies.
- d. To attend to medical or health care needs including compassionate requirements, and looking after the vulnerable.
- e. To attend a facility to receive a COVID-19 vaccination, where the individual is eligible for a vaccination in the ACT, an appointment has been booked, and the individual is not in isolation or in quarantine.
- f. To exercise outdoors, limited to one hour per day.
- g. For essential animal welfare purposes (e.g. to feed pets or livestock that live elsewhere).
- h. Leaving due to an emergency.
- 2. All individuals aged over 12 years must wear a mask at all times upon leaving their premises for the above-mentioned reasons. Mask wearing is not required if individuals are undertaking vigorous exercise outdoors.

In addition, the following conditions outlined in the *Public Health (COVID-19 Affected Areas) Emergency Direction* 2021, must be complied with:

Residents of the ACT must:

- 1. Complete a self-declaration using ACT Health's exemption form within 24 hours prior to arriving in the ACT, or within 24 hours from the commencement of a COVID-19 area of concern notice.
- Monitor for symptoms for 14 days from the date last in the area, and if you experience any symptoms of COVID-19 go to a COVID-19 clinic to be tested.

Non-Residents of the ACT must:

- 1. Not enter the ACT unless they obtain an exemption before arriving.
- 2. Where an exemption has been granted, comply with all Stay at Home requirements and/or any conditions outlined in the exemption documentation.

Notes:

- If you have been to a COVID-19 Place of Concern (Close Contact Exposure site or Casual Contact Exposure site) you
 must also comply with the requirements outlined in Schedule 3.
- If you have been in any listed LGA after 11:59pm on Friday 9 July 2021, you must comply with the requirements
 outlined in Schedule 1.
