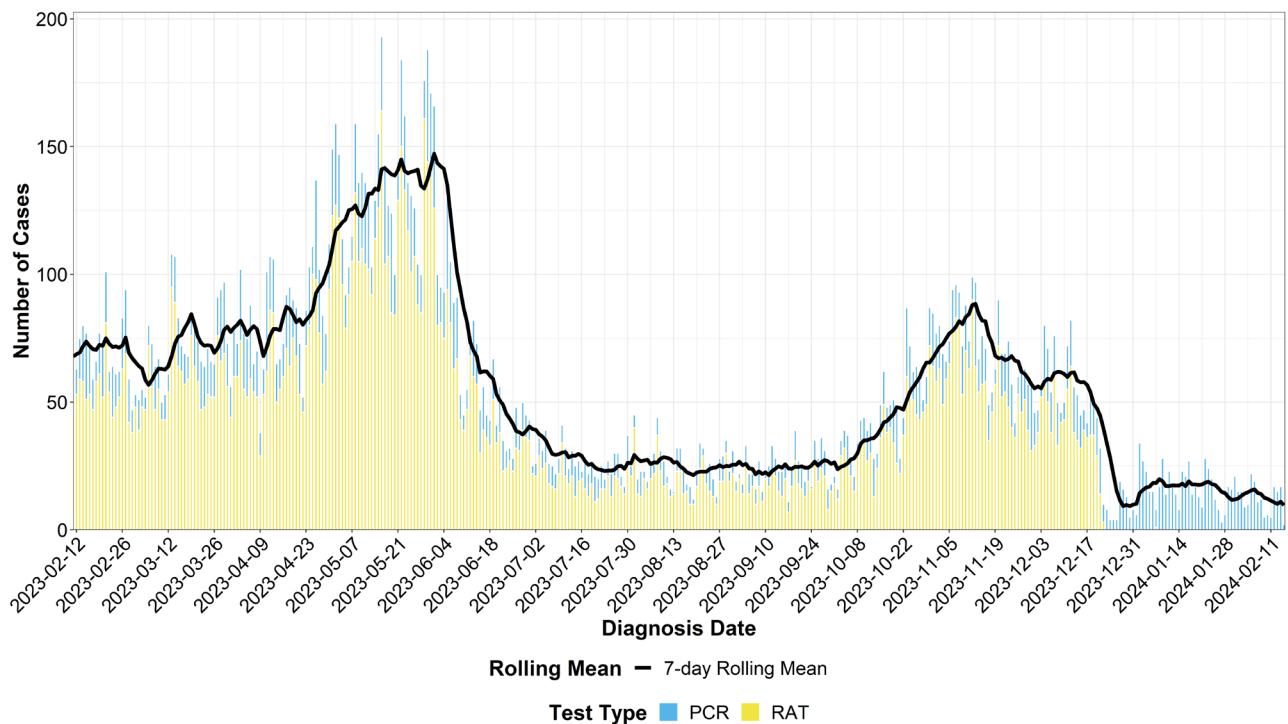

## COVID-19-related deaths

ACT Health has been notified of six COVID-19 related deaths, noting that none of these occurred during the reporting period; two males aged in their 70's, two males aged in their 80's, one female aged in her 70's and one female aged in her 80's.

There have been ten COVID-19 related deaths in 2024, bringing the total number of COVID-19-related deaths for the pandemic to 302.

<sup>c</sup>Due to the case processing system, there is a small proportion of cases that will not appear before the end of the cut-off period. This will result in an under-reporting of the case numbers and average mean for the 48 hours prior to the cut-off period.
