Tested positive to COVID-19?

Some of our mob may have a higher risk of serious illness from COVID-19. If you are in one of the groups on the back of this card and **you test positive to COVID-19**, have a yarn with your GP, a GP from Winnunga Nimmityjah (call **02 6284 6222)** or another medical specialist as soon as possible.

Talk to them about:

- » COVID-19 medications that might help you. These medications need to be started as soon as possible for the best results.
- » how to access other medical care while you have COVID-19.
- » Home monitoring to see if you need extra care and support.

You may have a higher risk of a serious COVID-19 illness if you are:

- an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person aged 50 years and over and have an underlying health condition
- aged 65 years and over and have an underlying health condition
- » pregnant and have an underlying health condition
- » aged 18 years and older and unvaccinated
- » moderately to severely immunocompromised.
