

COVID-19-related deaths

ACT Health has been notified of one COVID-19-related death during this reporting period; a male aged in his 60s. The death did not occur during this reporting period.

There have been 14 COVID-19-related deaths in 2024, bringing the total number of COVID-19-related deaths for the pandemic to 306.
